#### CLASS NOMINATION CONDITIONS

##### A,B,C Classes

Combinations may only enter 1 class of A, B or C. These classes will run concurrently

##### OFF THE TRACK

• Off The Track have sponsored an award for the best performed thoroughbred. This is open to Thoroughbreds that are 4 years old and over, and who are Connected and Registered with the OTT COMMUNITY. Registrations will be checked by the OC and provided to Racing Victoria. Racing Name and microchip number must be supplied at time of entry. • There is no limit as to how long they have been out of racing.

#### SATURDAY EVENING ENTERTAINMENT CLASSES

Will run early evening Saturday.

#### PRIZE MONEY

• Prize money will be paid via direct debit approx 7 days after the show, either back through the method of entry or via bank details only if filled out in rider profile. • Prize money will not be paid if any rider has outstanding fees or fees will be deducted from Prize money

#### RULES

- The event will be run under EA/FEI rules.
- The Organising Committee (OC) reserves the right to change or amend the program at its discretion. • All owners and competitors will be personally responsible for damages to any third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their animals. • Please ensure the safety of your children whilst in proximity to horses. • Ring 1 will follow draw order without exception. • Horses may start in a maximum of 2 classes per day. • No rider will be permitted more than 3 entries per class at the discretion of the OC. • Formal dress rules apply in all rings
- Presentations will be mounted, and riders are expected to wear their jackets. • Riders 18 years and under - riders aged 18 and under at the time of the event. • Riders 21 years and under - riders aged 21 and under at the time of the event. • Any person mounted upon a horse must be wearing a properly secured helmet and correct footwear. • The Organising Committee follows the EA stallion code of conduct. Guardians of riders/handlers under 17 years must take responsibility for stallions at all times including when leading, riding or stabling stallions throughout the venue.

#### REFUNDS & SCRATCHINGS

- Refunds will be given (less an admin fee up to \$25) before the close of entries. • After the close of entries, a 50% refund minus a \$25 admin fee will be given on production of a Veterinary or Medical Certificate for the horse(s) and/or rider(s) requested. Certificates must be received by 5pm 28<sup>th</sup> April 2023. • After the commencement of competition there will be no refunds. • Scratchings will only be accepted by email to [hello@melbourneshowjumpingclub.com](mailto:hello@melbourneshowjumpingclub.com) • If the event needs to be cancelled, refunds will be given less a \$10 admin fee.

#### MEMBERSHIPS AND REGISTRATIONS

- Horse, Owner and Rider must be current financial members with their Equestrian Australia appropriate state branch. • All horses nominated in Official classes must hold current registration and a Jumping Licence from EA • Registration checks will occur prior to the competition. Any horses or riders whose registration or Jumping License has not been renewed or purchased will be contacted by either Equestrian Victoria or the OC to correct this. Fines will be imposed, and all prize money forfeited should renewal or registration not be completed. • All competitors in must be financial members of EA and valid membership numbers must be recorded in your profile.

#### BEHAVIOUR

- Abuse: cruel and violent treatment of a person or animal. • Abusive behaviour towards any personnel involved in the organisation and running of this event will not be tolerated. Any person inflicting abuse upon such personnel will be asked to leave the premises and all entries will be forfeited. • The FEI requires all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the Horse must be paramount. ### EXTRA NOTES

#### WERRIBEE PARK NATIONAL EQUESTRIAN CENTRE RISK MANAGEMENT

- Approved Safety Helmets must be always worn when mounted
- Cross Country obstacles must not be jumped/used unless a non-riding level one NCAS coach is present.
- Riding of horses bareback is prohibited
- Riding of rugged and/or unbridled horses is prohibited
- Any person may lead a maximum of two horses while mounted
- Stallions must always be in the control of a person aged eighteen (18) years or
- Horses are not permitted within/upon the quadrangle (between the barn & Indoor 1).
- Horses are not permitted near pedestrian doorways
- Straw bedding is not permitted on the venue. Only wood shavings/sawdust bedding is accepted.
- Helmets must be worn when riding bikes or unpowered scooters.
- Bicycles are not permitted in the indoor arenas or any stable block.
- Bicycles are not permitted near doors designated as public entrances or exits.
- Electric Scooters are not permitted to be used on the venue.
- Speed limits must be always adhered to. The speed limit at WPNEC is 10km p/h.
- Power leads must not be on the ground or over roads
- Construction of portable/tape yards is prohibited
- Alcohol must not be consumed in the Indoor Arenas, unless purchased from the licensed bar located in Indoor Arena No 1.
- Please observe all signs at the venue.
- Horses must be tied in a safe manner. Horses must not be tied to unattached floats, wheelie bins, etc.
- No infrastructure to be erected on WPNEC Grounds without written approval by management prior to event.
- Entry and exit doors to Indoors Arenas must not be obstructed at any time.
- Every event to book at WPNEC must provide their own first aid officials.
- Report any incidents, damages, or safety concerns to WPNEC management immediately.
- Dogs are not permitted on the Cross-Country Course when in use.
- Please call WPNEC Management should you require any assistance with ANY Issue.
- Users who do not comply with these guidelines may be refused future use of WPNEC.

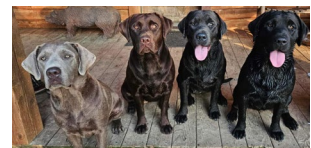
